**NOTICE: LOCAL UNION NO. 148 MEMBERS  
ELECTION OF OFFICERS**

1. Nominations for all officers shall be made from the floor only (written petitions for the nominations will not be accepted) at the regularly scheduled meetings during the month of **May**.

2. The following offices are to be filled for a term of three (3) years:

Business Manager  
President  
Vice President  
Recording-Corresponding Secretary  
Financial Secretary  
Treasurer  
Conductor  
Guard  
Trustees (3)

3. Within five (5) days after the nominations have been concluded at all meetings for all units, the Recording-Corresponding Secretary shall notify the candidates, in writing, of their nomination for office, and the office to which he/she was nominated.

4. The candidate must, within ten (10) days of the postmark on the envelope containing Attachment #2, Notification, in writing, by the Recording-Corresponding Secretary, file with the Recording-Corresponding Secretary, a written acceptance or rejection of nomination to the office.

5. The Recording-Corresponding Secretary, upon receipt of written acceptance of nomination to office, shall read, or cause to be read at all regularly scheduled meetings following the nominations and until election, the names of the candidates nominated.

6. To be eligible for Office, nominated candidates shall attend at least one regularly scheduled meeting held each month, after nominations and before the election. In the event that regularly scheduled Union meetings are not held in June and July, roll-call attendance will not be required.

The above requirements for Terms of Office and Conditions of Eligibility, are spelled out in the International Constitution, Article XXIV, Subdivision 1, Section (b).

In view of the fact that our forthcoming election will be conducted by a mail referendum ballot mailed to each member's last known address, it is imperative that our Union Office be kept notified of any change in your address.
